Then all you have to do is bring your work to Hudson Guild Gallery, 441 W. 26th Street (between 9th and 10th Avenues) on THURSDAY, JUNE 13, 2019 which is the opening night and reception, when you will be responsible for hanging your own work. All participants must be at the space by 6:00 PM in order to draw numbers in the first round. At 6:00 PM you will pick a number out of a hat which determines the order in which the pieces are to be hung. If you arrive after 6:00 PM, you will have to wait until all those who are on time have drawn their numbers before you get to hang your piece. While the reception goes on and refreshments are served, we'll give you a hammer and nail with which you hang your own work when your number is called. It's always a fun party so invite your family and friends too!
